### OUR MISSION

BCPLAN's mission is to increase access to credentials and employment opportunities. We accomplish this by facilitating the portability, recognition and acceptance of workplace and academic competencies.



### WHAT IS PLAR?

Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition is a process of assessing prior learning gained outside of a classroom (e.g. at work) and recognizing it as academic credit towards an educational credential.



### WHAT DO WE OFFER?

A communication network and learning community; we support innovative partnerships to facilitate increased access to credentials and long-term employment success for adults in BC.



### WHY DO WE DO IT?

BCPLAN believes adult learners should get the credit they deserve. Of the reported students that received PLAR in 2019, credential completion could add \$31 million to BC's economy.

### MICRO-CREDENTIALS AND BADGES
